1	Waitrose Solera Jerezana Fino del Puerto Lustau	16.5	£9.99	The typical bready nose of good fino sherry precedes a bright, fresh, full-flavoured yet supremely elegant palate	
2	Gonzales Byass Tio Pepe Fino	15	£10.00	A pale, straw-coloured wine, with a bouquet delicate (almondy) and sharp, without acidity, very dry and light on the palate	
3	Hidalgo La Gitana Manzanilla	15	£8.00	A bone-dry sherry from the well-regarded house of Hidalgo. Crisp and fresh with a salty tang from the sea breezes in Sanlucar	
4	Waitrose Solera Jerezana Palo Cortado Lustau	19	£9.99	Pale greenish gold, it is pungent with whiffs of gunsmoke and delightfully tangy and pretty dry on the palate	
5	Waitrose Solera Jerezana Dry Amontillado Lustau	19	£9.99	Distinctive nutty flavour of oak ageing but still with a dry tang	
6	Williams & Humbert 12-Year-Old Oloroso	19	2 x £8.69	Intense and classic oloroso aromas of walnuts, almonds and dried fruit. Luscious yet perfectly balanced this is a deliciously rich, dry style with a smooth finish	
7	Valdaspino Olorosa Solera 1842 VOS	21	£39.95	An intense mahogany colour. Notes of rich dried fruits, nuts and caramel. Smooth and full bodied on the palate with excellent length	
8	Valdaspino Pedro Ximénez El Candado	17	£19.95	A deep mahogany colour. Intense aromas of dried fruits, raisins, figs, and subtle notes of chocolate and coffee. Smooth and velvety on the palate, with great length and balance
